4. In v19 Paul states four things about these enemies of the cross. Note these four things and comment on what each may mean.
5. In v19-21 Paul contrasts the concerns of non-Christians and Christians. What are

the concerns/focus of each group?

6. How do we increasingly develop the focus that we should have?
7. What should being citizens of such a great Kingdom affect how we live here?
8. What is wrong with the statement "he/she was so heavenly minded they were no earthly good."
9. What reasons sometimes dampen our desire for the coming again of Christ?
10. What will happen when Christ returns v21? What impact should this have on our lives?
